- Leather softens and beautifies as it ages.
- Leather is a natural material and small surface imperfections are common, making each piece unique and one of a kind.
- Clean using quality leather conditioning products free of silicone or wax.
- Test on an inconspicuous area before use.
- Avoid harsh chemicals, shoe creams, saddle soap, alcohol, or animal fats products that may cause stitching and leather to rot.
- Avoid excessive sunlight and heat.
- Avoid sharp objects in pockets, such as keys, that may scratch the leather.
- Following these guidelines will allow your leather to provide many years of useful service.
